NFPA Required Piping Purity Test

One of the proposals for the 2024 Edition of NFPA 99 was to look at the Piping Purity test and what chemicals are being looked for and what should be looked for. The piping committee acknowledged that this is something that maybe warrants attention, but without data to go by, there was not much that could be done. To that end, in MGPHO BOD discussions we have decided to form an ad hoc MGPHO Committee to gather data and analysis regarding the piping purity test.

We would like to start work quickly as we only have until early June before our public input will have to be submitted for the 2027 edition.

Scott Petrunick has agreed to chair this committee. There will also soon be a forum category to add input.

We will be sending an email out to those who have expressed interest in the next week to get work started in early 2024.

The RFA and the Required Permit to Work System

One of the new items in the 2021 code was the addition of the RFA (Responsible Facility Authority) and their requirement to create a permit to work system.

5.1.14.2.1 The Responsible Facility Authority of the health care facility shall develop, maintain, and manage a permit-to-work system ensuring uninterrupted quality, quantity, and continuity of supply during all piped medical gas and vacuum system maintenance, repair, or construction work.

There are 7 additional items following section 5.1.14.2.1. Many of the MGPHO members are service providers to healthcare facilities and many of those facilities are looking to us for assistance not only in training an RFA but also implementing the policies and forms for this permit to work system.

AS a MGPHO BOD, we were discussing what additional values MGPHO can bring to both new and existing members. We have decided to move forward with creating an ad hoc committee to develop policies, procedures and forms that could be used for the permit to work system.

MGPHO Special Expert, Mark Allen has agreed to chair this committee. There will soon be a forum category to provide input as well.

We will be sending an email out to those who have expressed interest in the next week to get work started in early 2024.

Call for Abstracts 2024 Annual Conference


We are starting to look for speakers for next years conference in Tampa. Please get with Rocky Plotts VP Education if you have any ideas, speakers or would like to present something.




